Program Guideline

Concise Step-through Guide:

1. Once program has loaded, click on "New Design" to begin planning your new kitchen.
 - Click on "Open Design" to continue working on a previously saved kitchen design.
2. Enter your kitchen dimensions and window and door locations in millimetres.
3. Start your design by dragging and dropping the units into the room and rotate to get the right orientation. Position the cabinets close to the adjacent cabinets and it will align itself. At any stage you can edit room dimensions or doors and windows, but this will clear the design and cause you to restart.
4. At any stage if you are having overlapping problems please restart the design.
5. Select the "Finishes" Tab to choose the benchtop, cabinet door, handle, and kickboard finishes.
6. Select "List" from the toolbar to preview the list of selected cabinets and finishes chosen.
7. Select "Print" to preview and print the kitchen design, benchtop layout, cabinet list, selection of finishes and filler and panel list.
8. Select "Price" on the toolbar to get the price of your design.
9. Select "Email" to email your proposed design and order. A AuctionsRus representative will contact you once your email has been received.
10. Please email us on the contact us page to comment on any problems or joys you are having with the program. It is being developed continuously so feedback is appreciated.

Design

- Drag cabinets from left panel into main window and rotate as appropriate.
- If you have made an error, click on the cabinet and "X" to delete it. "XX" will delete the complete design
- Make sure you are aware of the cabinet heights you are using. There are 2 systems:
 - 2100mm, using 600 high wall cabinets and 1960 (excluding the kickboard 140mm) high tall cabinets and
 - 2300mm, using 800 high wall cabinets and 2160 (excluding the kickboard 140mm) high tall cabinets.
- All cabinets finish at the same height, either 2100 or 2300. Cabinets of different heights can be used but be aware of this.
- Panels should be added by double clicking the cabinet and selecting the panel for inclusion on the left or right of the cabinet depending on the visible external surfaces.
 - In the situation of an island or a breakfast bar the panel called a barback should also be selected to cover the unit back because it is a visible surface.
 - In the situation of an enclosed fridge the panels are selected and then the fridge is moved into position on the wall. A fridge cabinet is placed in position above the fridge between the panels. There may be situations in which the panels have not

accounted for This will be checked when forwarding your design to the AuctionsRus help desk.

- Cabinet detail view: In the situation where you have a breakfast bar or island benchtop, you must double click the cabinet or highlight the cabinet and click the magnifying glass. This gives all panel details of the cabinet. For cabinets needing Bar Backs please select the option for barback and the 600mm or 900mm benchtop. Also in this window a selection can be made for glass doors, standard doors or no doors. Hardware is still supplied for the doors in this situation so you are able to supply your own doors.
- Fillers are automatically inserted for spaces of 150mm and less.
- When placing cabinets, the bottom right corner of the screen gives the available distance to the left and right of the selected cabinet so you can choose the correct cabinet size to place in the space.
- Appliances: Sinks and cooktops are placed on the benchtop, whilst dishwashers, freestanding stoves and range hoods are inserted like cabinets. You have a choice of microwave or dishwasher cabinets and range hood cabinets with or without appliances. The cabinets are the same, but the difference being that the appliances are listed for your convenience and to get pricing. The fridge is to be inserted after the panels have been selected by double clicking the refrigerator in the room. The fridge is then moved onto the wall and the cabinet placed above the fridge between the panels.
- When starting a design it is best to start with a corner unit and work your way around the room. Place floor and tall cabinets and appliances, and then place wall units fridges, range hoods, sinks and cooktops.
- The choice to display numbers on the cabinets can be selected by altering the view to make reading the list easier. The benchtop and widths can also be turned on or off to simplify the drawing.

Finishes

- Once satisfied with your design, click on "Finishes" in the top menu.
- Choose your desired benchtop finishes, handle styles and cabinet and kickboard colours. Prices vary according to the finishes. To view real samples of the finishes please order a sample box of standard finish selection from the online store.

3D

- To view your design in 3D click the "3D" button and you will have an image of your proposed design in the finish selection you have made. By holding down the right mouse button and moving the mouse you can rotate and zoom the image. To change the finishes click on the finishes button and reselect your finishes and then click the 3D button to redo your view. To print the 3D image press the print screen key on your computer and paste the resulting image into a word or notepad document.

List

- Click on "List" in the top menu to see an overview of the items included in your proposed kitchen.

Price

- Click on "Price" in the top menu to view an estimate quote for your proposed kitchen. You can go back to the finish button and re-choose finishes and then re-price the design as many times as you like.
- You can save the design by selecting save from the toolbar and then starting a new design. You can then recall and price the saved job at any time.
- Please note, at the moment pricing does not include appliances.

Save

- To save a kitchen design, click "Save" in the top menu and select a save destination. You can recall and re-choose finishes and re-price the design at any time.
- When saving, save it under the customers surname first then the invoice number followed by the store name. Eg. Smith1459Toowoomba. This will allow easy tracking for when the kitchen is delivered.

Print

- This will give a comprehensive list in print form of the selections: panels, fillers, appliances and bench top sizes which can be faxed to the AuctionsRus help desk or your nearest supplier. They can also be taken in when visiting a AuctionsRus showroom.

Email

- Click the "Email" button, fill out your contact information, and then click the "Send" button and confirm the transmission. You will need to attached the kitchen plan to the – email. The design will then be forwarded to the AuctionsRus help desk to check your design; and contact will be made to your email address.

3D

- To view your design in 3D click the "3D" button and you will have an image of your proposed design in the finish selection you have made. By holding down the right mouse button and moving the mouse you can rotate and zoom the image. To change the finishes click on the finishes button and reselect your finishes and then click the 3D button to redo your view. To print the 3D image press the print screen key on your computer and paste the resulting image into a word or notepad document.

QUALITY CABINETS: All SmartPack cabinets are made from the very best materials using 16mm highly moisture resistant particle board with PVC edges. The backs of all the cabinets and drawer bottoms are also made from this 16mm board. All shelving is adjustable and quality metal sided Blum Metabox drawers runners and Hettich clip on hinges are included with every SmartPack. All associated hardware for panels, benchtops and wall fixings are supplied, including handles. Legs for floor cabinets are adjustable with click on kickboards.

PERSONAL CHOICE: You have total flexibility and choice on a range of cabinet and door finishes and benchtops colours. SmartPack has a range of doors in stock or made to order.

READILY AVAILABLE: All SmartPacks cabinets are in stock, with a range of door finishes also in stock.

EASY ASSEMBLY: All boards are labelled and predrilled to enable easy installation with an expanding cam and dowel system. The adjustable shelves, hinge hole plates and drawer runner holes are even predrilled for your convenience. There is also a drilling jig supplied for handle holes. All SmartPack cabinets are supplied with instructions for installation.

EASILY TRANSPORTABLE: All SmartPack cabinets are boxed in individual cartons for ease of transporting and storage. There is a delivery service available.

WARRANTY: SmartPacks come with a 7 year workmanship warranty and limited lifetime warranty on all the hardware.
